## Fall Columbiette Retreat

Our annual Fall Spiritual Retreat is scheduled for Friday through Sunday, September 24, 25 & 26 and will be held at the St Francis Prayer Center in Stoneville.

Hello Ladies,

Hope all are doing well. Wanted to give you an update on our retreat. WONDERFUL news.....Here is the bio of Jane Brock, the lady who will be leading our retreat:

A former Episcopal priest who converted to the Roman Catholic Church, Jane Brock has been on the staff of three Episcopal churches, and has led numerous Bible studies, Quiet Day meditations, and retreats. Before attending the seminary she was a Social Worker for over 20 years working with abused and neglected children and adults. Her passion is helping others live most fully into the purpose for which God created them, and she counts it a privilege to be part of the journey of those seeking the fullness of life. A native of Tennessee, she has lived in North Carolina for eight years. Now a Hospice Chaplin, Jane is an active laywoman at St Matthews Catholic Church in Charlotte, NC, where she is an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, a Bible study teacher, a member of the RCIA team and the facilitator of Cenacle of Divine Mercy. I am so excited!

Here is the situation, for the last several years we have not filled up the facility at St Francis Springs. We were averaging 22-25 ladies. We (the Columbiettes) had to put down a deposit for this year about 2 years ago. Holy Cross put the

deposit of \$200.00 which held 12 rooms with enough beds or sofa beds to accommodate 29 ladies. I anticipate this to fill up quickly. I thought the "fair" thing to do is open the registration to those ladies who attended last year and also Anne Sullivan, who will become State President on July 1, 2010, along with Sara Warnecke and the other lady who provided me the information for this speaker.

I do not have email addresses for the following ladies who attended last year: Kathy Schoenborn, Muriel Peeling, Marie McCann and Theresa Woods. So I will try and make contact by telephone. If any of you can contact these ladies, please do so.

**Please contact me by email or telephone by: Monday, May 31, 2010, and let me know if you will be attending this year.** I will need a \$25.00, non refundable deposit to be received by June 12, 2010.

Checks are made out to Holy Cross Columbiettes so I may deposit them and write the check to St Francis Springs. The room charge is \$80.00 per night and that includes all meals. As usual, we also give a stipend to both Fr Louie and Jane Brock. I have to firm up the number of attendees by May 31, 2010, so I may release the other rooms for Columbiettes who did not attend last year to be able to book.

Next year we have the entire facility and will be able to accommodate more.

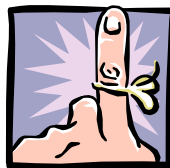

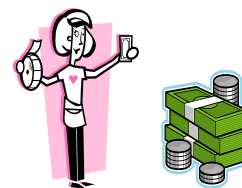
