Accordingly, in exchange for the services, instruction, uniform, and equipment provided to my child by the Lenape Valley Soccer Club and its authorized representatives, I/we hereby fully release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the Lenape Valley Soccer Club, and its past, present and future coaches, officials, trainers, organizers, participants, board members, and persons transporting my/our child to and from activities, from any claims, causes of action, demands, rights or liabilities of every nature and description arising out of any injury to my/our child – whether the result of negligence or for any other cause – known or unknown. Based on the fact that my child is a minor, should any occasion arise regarding the health or welfare of my child which would require authorization or approval from me, I give the right to grant said authorization to his/her coaches, trainers, the Lenape Valley Soccer Club and/or its officials.

I/We do hereby give consent to fire and rescue, and hospital emergency personnel for the immediate treatment of the above-named child necessitated by injury or illness incurred while engaged in activities sponsored by the Lenape Valley Soccer Club or in travel to and from said activities. In the event I/ we are physically present when injury or illness occurs, or during treatment for same, then this consent form shall be invalid and all treatments shall be subject to my/our consent.

Travel teams! Competition vs. other clubs

The Lenape Valley Soccer Club organizes and operates travel, known as PA Rush, teams for both males and females. Travel has increased costs and involves year round participation. Upon acceptance on a team, an additional \$100.00 travel player fee will be due, payable to the club. This additional money will support training, field time, and all the other areas that it takes to support a year round sports program. Each travel team will create their own budget based on coach guided training/tournaments/additional leagues, etc. An important goal of the PA Rush program is the age appropriate development of young players. Our coaches strive to teach not only appropriate technical and tactical aspects of the game, they also focus on sportsmanship and the overall development of the child. In general, the program also focuses on providing a system to help players reach their full potential.

Registration is necessary to try-out for a travel team... please make sure you check a box, either travel to refund or travel to intramural for the chance your child does not make a travel team. All registered candidates are welcome and invited to try-out. While it is our best intention to complete a try-out list for each coach, please be proactive in contacting the age appropriate travel coach to express interest and obtain try-out dates. Intramural is about fun! Playing within the community.

Intramural provides an opportunity for kids to play the great game of soccer. Intramural focuses on providing each child with a well-rounded soccer experience. The goal is to develop skill at all player positions and assist each child reach their best potential. Intramurals encourages children to enjoy recreation, develop new friendships and to have FUN. Sportsmanship and learning skills for the game are featured. Games are on local fields and for the majority, games and practices are held just Monday-Saturday.

Children are re-mixed on different teams each season to develop camaraderie within the age group and expose each child to a variety of coaches. Teams are assembled to be as equal as possible. This is about fun and a high level of "friendly" competition.

Volunteer support is expected. Intramural needs everybody's contribution of some time or talent to keep this growing club working. Thus, please pay close attention to the volunteer request on the form. If you have more than one child in the intramural program, you need only volunteer in one age group. Any registration form submitted without volunteering, or paying the non-volunteer fee, cannot be accepted. We really need the help, not the non-volunteer fee option.

Younger children: Under 5 and 6 (U5) & (U6) age groups have one practice per week with 1 game on Saturday.

Older children: Under 7 (U7) and older groups will have two practices per week with 1 game on Saturday. There may be additional games played on weekday evenings.

Sorry - We Cannot Honor Special Requests. Due to Club size, our emphasis on proper player development and a desire for equal and fair team assignments, there are NO requests accepted for specific team placement, coaches, or practice times. This policy reflects the club's interest in fair play, developing camaraderie within the entire age group, as well as a desire to have players interact with many different players and coaches. Children WILL NOT be allowed to "move up" age divisions. If your child cannot practice on certain days because of prior commitments then indicate on the application; we will **TRY**, but we cannot guarantee to honor those requests.
