

IMPORTANT READ CAREFULLY

TERMS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS OF APPLICATION - YOUR SIGNATURE INDICATES THAT YOU AGREE TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Allotment of stable accommodations is no more than a revocable license or permit, which Rockingham Venture, Inc. may revoke or withdraw at any time. A stall can be assigned to another only by Rockingham Venture, Inc. Stall assignments are valid through September 1, 2009 or until further notice.
2. The acceptance and use of stalls or the entry of a horse in a race by an applicant constitutes an agreement that the applicant shall comply with and abide by the Rules and Regulations of the USTA, New Hampshire Pari-Mutuel Commission and the Rules and Regulations of Rockingham Venture, Inc. The applicant further consents and agrees to accept as final and binding the decision of the Management and Pari-Mutuel Commission on all matters to or arising out of racing.
3. This license to occupy stalls is subject to revocation without cause, upon the giving of 48 hours written notice to the applicant, or the violation of the rules and regulations of the USTA, the Pari-Mutuel Commission or of Rockingham Venture, Inc. or of the State of New Hampshire shall subject this license to immediate revocation at the sole discretion of Rockingham Venture, Inc.
4. Applicant agrees that neither Rockingham Venture, Inc. nor any of its officers, agents, servants, employees or representatives, shall be liable under any circumstance for any loss, cost, damage, injury or expense occasioned the applicant, the owner or the trainer, driver, agent, servant or employee of the applicant or owner, or the animals or property of any of them, arising out of or from any cause whatsoever occurring on the grounds or property of Rockingham Venture, Inc., or on the grounds leased or used by Rockingham Venture, Inc. and the applicant and owner hereby agree to hold Rockingham Venture, Inc., its officers, agents, servants, employees or representatives, harmless and indemnify them from any such loss, cost, damage, injury or expense. All risks of loss, injury, damage or destruction to person, property and/or horses by fire, theft, accident or otherwise, are assumed in full by such owners, trainers and drivers, their agents, servants and employees whether caused by active or passive negligence, condition of the premises or any other reason or cause whatsoever.
5. The applicant does for himself, his/her employees and all persons for whom he is acting, consent to all simulcasting both within the State of New Hampshire and with other jurisdictions to which Rockingham may be a party.
6. The applicant grants his consent to be photographed in a motion picture or television program without remuneration to him and agrees to obtain such consent of his driver, trainer, employees, agents, or associates and upon demand any of the aforementioned persons shall deliver releases to Rockingham Venture, Inc., permitting it to use and exhibit such photographic material. Rockingham Venture, Inc. may televise or authorize or license the televising of certain horse races to be conducted in its racing plant and accordingly it hereby reserves all rights to television whether in connection with any race, preparation thereof, or ceremonies or proceedings thereafter, or training at the track. All entries are accepted on the condition that such consent is hereby given for the owner, driver, trainer, groom and all other employees of the owner or trainer coming within the view of the television picture.
7. If upon expiration of 48 hours from the time of notice to vacate stalls, tack rooms and/or grooms quarters, the applicant shall not have removed from Rockingham Park the horse(s) or personal property in his ownership, custody or control, Rockingham Venture, Inc. shall be entitled at the expense of the applicant, to remove the same to a public or private stable or store the same elsewhere and, upon the expiration of 30 days from the date of notice, to sell such horse(s) or property by private or public auction and apply the proceeds in payment of any expense incurred by Rockingham. In no event shall Rockingham Venture, Inc., nor any of its agents, officers, employees or representatives be responsible to the owner or applicant for the condition, removal, stabling, storage or sale of any horse(s) or property as foresaid.
8. Horse owners and trainers must protect themselves by insurance. Workmen's Compensation Insurance is required in the state of New Hampshire.
9. Rockingham Venture, Inc. reserves the right to reject any entry.
10. All horses must be approved by the Racing Secretary prior to their coming on the grounds. You must have the horse's name, age, sex and last starting date to be considered for a stall. This applies to all trainers.
11. Horsemen who race at Rockingham Park do so subject to the provisions of the agreement between Rockingham Venture, Inc. and the Western New England Harness Horsemen's Association.
12. **Horses stabled on the grounds at Rockingham Park are to be raced at Rockingham Park. Rockingham Park adheres to a strict 60-day claiming rule. No horse may be raced at another track within that 60-day period (Stake races excluded.)**
13. Firearms are not permitted on the premises.
14. There shall be no jogging of horses or towing, around the stable area. Towing is permitted on the practice track only.
15. All horses should be inoculated for EEE and WNV.
16. All buildings, stables, vehicles and persons in the stable area or on the track at Rockingham are subject to search and inspection by Rockingham Security and/or the New Hampshire Pari-Mutuel Commission.
17. Purse distribution in overnight events shall be 50-25-12-8-5% unless otherwise specified.

IMPORTANT

No horse will be admitted on the grounds without a veterinarian issued health certificate within ten days.

All nerved horses must be approved for racing by the State Veterinarian.
