

Roxbury Historic District Commission

15 July 2009

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm. C. Haver chaired.

The minutes of the 17 June meeting were accepted with clerical errors corrected.

Town Hall – B. Henry brought samples of the roof material. The singles are a larger size than those on the roof now. The HDC went out to inspect the roof and look at the sample in natural light. The HDC agreed that the larger shingle was a better scale for the long roof; the color – slate – also was appropriate. B. Henry will submit an application. After the new roof, the Town Hall will be painted and new wood shutters attached. The present building is off white with white trim. The HDC felt either off white/white or white/white would be fine. The shutters will be dark green.

In other business, B. Henry reported on the proposed hot dog stand. The trailer will be replaced by a barn-like structure, but the Porta-Potty and the picnic tables will remain. The regulations for food handling are rigorous and will be closely monitored. In any case, the hot dog stand will not be opened until next year.

Nathan Smith barns – The barns have been altered: stall doors have been cut into the west side. The HDC agreed that W. Walker should write a note to the owner, citing the regulations and enclosing an application.

Preservation Award – J. Huber brought the plaque. It will be presented when the Chair returns from holiday.

HD walking tour - The volunteers have walked the HD several times and there will be a “dress rehearsal” 20 June Monday starting at the Senior Center.

Market fence – There is still no fence around the exhaust fans. G. Miller will e-mail Burman.
