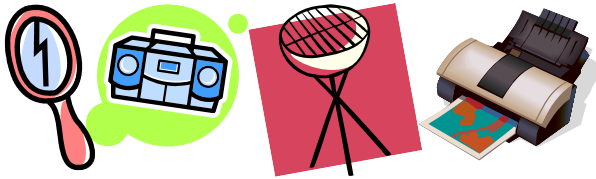

Rules for Residents



ALL materials deposited at the Transfer Station must originate within the Town of Roxbury and be from residential properties. Let the Attendant know if you know of someone from out of town is using our Transfer Station.

Stickers are required on all vehicles. Stickers must be affixed on the lower left portion of the windshield. If it is not so placed, the driver will be denied use of the Transfer Station.

The following are not accepted:

- Grass (lawn) clippings & leaves
- Tree stumps or logs/stone
- Hazardous Waste
- Septic Waste
- Materials that have not been prepared for collection, collected or transported in accordance with the Town's Ordinance.



<p>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</p> 	<p>Only clean, dry corrugated cardboard (waffle middle) that has no plastic or waxed surface</p>	<p>Flatten and tie Keep clean and dry</p>	<p>Waxed corrugated Pizza boxes Non-corrugated Cereal boxes Wet cardboard</p>

<p>WASTE OIL/ANTIFREEZE</p>	<p>Waste oil/antifreeze drained from engines</p>	<p>Separate, Operator will pour into metal tanks</p>	<p>Do not mix with other liquids</p> 
<p>SCRAP METAL</p>	<p>Metal items such as appliances, grills propane tanks (give to attendant)</p>	<p>See posted disposal charges in this flyer</p> 	<p>Rubber, plastic or other metallic components</p>
<p>PLASTICS</p>	<p>Code 1 (PET) and Code 2 (HDPE)</p> 	<p>Washed clean, labels attached OK, caps off</p>	<p>#3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 plastics Lids/covers/oil containers and plastic bags</p>
