***The Fall Bible Study series has just begun. Will this program change when the new Fine Arts Center/Multi-purpose facilities are available?***

The Bible Study program is currently held in the Family Center. We would like to expand the program by adding outside speakers and presentations, as well as add more daytime sessions to our schedule. As with many of the smaller prayer groups, it is difficult to have a quiet, meaningful program in the Family Center during school hours because of the gym schedule. The Centering Prayer Group presently meets in the school library because it is the quietest place we could find! The new facilities will definitely give us more space and greater flexibility in scheduling.

***Plans are being made for a Liturgical Conference to be held in the spring. How would this change if the Fine Arts Center were available?***

We expect over 300 participants at this conference, which will include many of the various ministries in our parish. Currently, the only place large enough to accommodate a group of this size is the church. The new Fine Arts Center would give us not only additional meeting space, but allow us to schedule multiple presentations for the same event.
