### ***What will change in the CCD program when the new Fine Arts and Gymnasium facilities become available?***

The biggest change for our program, currently serving almost 300 children, will be that during group functions, our children will no longer have to sit on the floor! We desperately need a place to have group events for speakers, presentations and programs. We also need more classroom space. We now have classes in all the school classrooms, the art room and meeting rooms in the Family Center. Several of our classes need to be split into smaller groups. Most important, the new facilities will allow us to expand our programs to include music ministry and more group functions.

### ***Adult Education and VIRTUS classes are usually held at night. Will this change?***

Most of our Adult Education and VIRTUS (Safe Environment) classes are scheduled for evening hours because conducting a class in the Family Center when the children are having gym class (which happens sometimes on a daily basis) is very difficult. When the new facilities are available we will have the opportunity to change our scheduling and offer day and evening classes.
