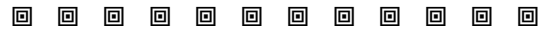

Capital Campaign Communication Building Update By: Shannon Xiques

The Capital Campaign Communications Committee would like to report on the status of the parish's/school's new Fine Arts Center and Multi-Purpose Building. As members of the parish, it is of great importance that you be kept informed on the progress of the new buildings. Your generous pledges have made this much-needed expansion possible.

Phase 1 of the Fine Arts Center Building and Phase 1 of the site work for the Multi-Purpose Building is well on its way. All site work has been completed. All of the utility work inspections are completed and are currently being tested. The foundation is complete, and all underground rough-ins for plumbing, mechanical and electrical have been completed and are in place. We are also very pleased to report that the wall framing is 100% complete. Framing and most of the roof have also been finished. It's a true blessing to have the building progress going so well.

The Building Committee met with the site architect (FWA) and the contractor (Fraser) on Thursday, May 8, 2008, to choose the stucco, shingles, brick, exterior paint colors, and windows for the Fine Arts Center Building. These suggestions made by Fraser and FWA will give the parish the opportunity to reduce the current construction cost estimate. The committee evaluated the suggested changes and advised the architect and contractor of any agreed upon modifications. The revised cost estimate and updated financial analysis will be sent to John Barker, CFO Diocese of Charleston, in early June so he will have an opportunity to review it prior to the July DB & RC meeting. Also during the meeting, Fraser advised the committee that they are currently on schedule. As of May 21, 2008 all of the Dry-in was completed. By July 3, 2008, the inspection for permanent power will be finished. On August 8 – 12, 2008, the Town of Hilton Head will complete the Certificate of Occupancy Inspection. Lastly, with the grace of God and your continued support, the parish/school will be able to move in to the new facility on August 13, 2008.
