

INTERNET RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Each student needs to be registered in the program.

A family needs to have internet access at home or it will be difficult for your child to fully participate in the program.

Parents will be provided:

- Weekly lesson schedule
- Students will be issued a student book
- Instructions for the internet
- Periodic email updates including copies of *Partners in Faith*.

Note: If you are not getting an email at least once a month, it means we do not have a current email address. Please send an email asking us to add your family to the distribution list. We will use the address of your email shown in the "From" line of the message unless you otherwise instruct us.

Each week a parent will review the lesson with the child using the student book. Discuss the information on each of the student pages and let the child fill in the blanks, where required.

Parents can pull additional information and activities, should they choose, from the Catechist and Teachers site at the www.faithfirst.com web site.

Upon completion of the chapter the student needs to log on to www.faithfirst.com

- Select Legacy Edition
- Select the grade and chapter
- Answer the review questions

The RE office will record chapter review results and credit the child with attendance for that class. There is no formal lesson for Thanksgiving. Parents will need to E-Mail the Director to let her know these lessons were covered.

The Director of Religious Education will schedule children, by grade, to come in for Unit reviews to assess progress, about 4 times during the school year.

On weeks when your child is able to attend the Wednesday evening RE, he/she should bring his/her student book to class and take it back home at the end of class.

If your child can join us for those classes, we will also have a prayer service the last class before each of these holidays.
