1. Read the life of your Saint. List the title and author of your reference books at the end of your report. The Religious Education Office has several books on the lives of the Saints which you may borrow. It is alright to use the Internet.
2. In the **FIRST PARAGRAPH**, tell why you choose this Saint. A paragraph should have 3-5 good sentences.
3. In the **NEXT THREE PARAGRAPHS**, summarize **IN YOUR OWN WORDS** the life of the Saint.
4. The **FIFTH PARAGRAPH** is to describe at least three qualities you most admire in this Saint and how the Saint demonstrated these qualities.
5. In the **FINAL PARAGRAPH**, explain your present plan for incorporating these qualities into your own life.
6. Make an **ATTRACTIVE COVER** with your Saint's Name and Your Name.
7. Be sure that your Report is typed. Proofread for spelling, punctuation, etc.
