# Great Schedule

## General Rules and Regulations

1. Management, the Committee, and/or Swan Lake Stables will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any exhibitor, owner, attendant, horse or equipment at the show.
2. Management reserves the right to cancel any class if the required entries have not been received, and to combine any division if necessary, to change an obstacle or alter any course.
3. ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Harness is required when jumping for all competitors.
4. Riders Must Show in a minimum of 3 shows and be present at the March finale to qualify for series end awards.
5. For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor will be considered as of the first day of the schooling series and remains the same throughout.
6. All exhibitors must appear in proper attire.
7. NO person will be allowed in the ring at any time unless invited in by the management.
8. The State of Pennsylvania requires that all horses and ponies must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate taken within 12 months. Bring Coggins Certificate to the secretary.
9. A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for all returned checks.
10. **Every horse on grounds must be entered** whether showing or not and pay the Non-Show Fee of \$35.00/per horse. Anyone not entered and caught on the grounds will be charged \$150.00/per horse facility use charge.
11. Office Fee - \$10.00                      Schooling Fee - \$10.00/per Horse
12. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded in all divisions.
13. Six Ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
14. Entry fee will be \$15.00 per class
15. Stalls are available for \$75 per night  
All stall fees are nonrefundable once received. Riders reserving a stall may warm-up from 1pm - 5pm in the Hunter rings the day before the show. This will be at no additional cost. Riders without a stall wishing to ship in the day before for warm-up will be charged \$15.00.
16. Exhibitors that do not purchase shavings from the horse show will pay a \$25 disposal fee for bedding removal.
17. **Warning** - In accordance with PA Act #93 of 2005 you assume the risk of Equine Activities Pursuant to Pennsylvania Law.
18. Please use designated parking areas. You will be asked to move your vehicle if it is parked in the No Parking areas. There is no driving on the show grounds.

### **Walk-Trot Hunter Division**

Open to all amateur riders. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability to rider and soundness. Martingales prohibited. (Will be split by age if entries warrant.)

Class 1 - Walk Hunter - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk.

Class 2 - Walk-Trot Hunter - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.

### **Short Stirrup Equitation Division**

Open to riders **13 years of age and under**. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider 50% and equitation of rider 50%. Fences 18”.

Class 3 - Short Stirrup Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. Martingales prohibited.

Class 4 - Short Stirrup Walk-Trot-Canter - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Martingales prohibited.

Class 5 - Short Stirrup Over Fences - To be shown over 4 - 8 fences.

### **Long Stirrup Equitation Division**

Open to riders **14 years of age and over**. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider 50% and equitation of rider 50%. Fences 18”.

Class 6 - Long Stirrup Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. Martingales prohibited.

Class 7 - Long Stirrup Walk-Trot-Canter - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Martingales prohibited.

Class 8 - Long Stirrup Over Fences - To be shown over 4 - 8 fences.

### **Easy Does It Hunter Division**

Open to all riders. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 18” and will include a change of direction. Trot or canter fences will be split under 13 and under and 14 and over if more than 20 entries.

Class 9 - Easy Does It Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 10 - Easy Does It Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 11 - Easy Does It Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. (No more than 8 riders to canter at a time.) Martingales prohibited.

### **Children’s Hunter Pony Division**

Open to children who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st. Ponies 14.2 hands and under. To be judged on manners, performance and suitability of pony to rider. Fences 2’ small/medium, 2’3” Large.

Class 12 - Children’s Hunter Pony Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 13 - Children’s Hunter Pony Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 14 - Children’s Hunter Pony Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Martingales prohibited.

### **Hopeful Hunter Division**

Open to horses and ponies (ponies may be ridden by an adult). To be judged on manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2' . Will be split for points and ribbons: Professional/Non Professional if over 25 entries. Please declare your status at the secretaries booth.

Class 15 - Hopeful Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 16 - Hopeful Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 17 - Hopeful Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Martingales prohibited.

### **Schooling Hunter Division**

Open to horses and ponies (ponies may be ridden by an adult). To be judged on manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2' 3" or 2'6". Will be split for points and ribbons: Professional/Non Professional if over 25 entries. Please declare your status at the secretaries booth.

Class 18 - Schooling Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 19 - Schooling Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 20 - Schooling Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Martingales prohibited.

### **Children Hunter Horse Division**

Open to horses and riders who have not reached their 18 years as of December 1st. To be judged on manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2'6".

Class 22 - Children Hunter Horse Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 23 - Children Hunter Horse Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 24 - Children Hunter Horse Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Martingales prohibited.

### **Open Hunter Division**

Open to All. To be judged on manners, suitability and soundness. Fences 2'9" or 3'.

Class 25 - Open Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 26 - Open Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences.

Class 27 - Open Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Martingales prohibited.

#### *Class 21 - Swan Lake Jr./Adult Medal - 2'*

Choose 2', 2'3" or 2'6". Rider may increase the height of their fences throughout the series but may not decrease.

Top 6 riders will be called back for work on the flat. Flat work will be without martingales.

**Will be divided and pinned separately for the juniors and adults.**

Choose 2', 2'3" or 2'6". Rider may increase the height of their fences throughout the series but may not decrease.

**From Frederick traveling on Route 15 North** - Take the Route 116 Exit (Hanover St.) - Right off exit. Go 4 miles to Bonneauville, after curve take immediate right onto Maple Street. **Stay left at fork (Maple becomes White Hall)**. Go 2.5 miles, see sign on left - Honda Acres, take left onto Honda Road. Immediate right onto Schoolhouse Road. Farm 3/4 mile on left.

**From Harrisburg traveling on Route 15 South** - Take the Route 116 Exit (Hanover St.) - Left off exit. Go 4 miles to Bonneauville, after curve take immediate right onto Maple Street. **Stay left at fork (Maple becomes White Hall)**. Go 2.5 miles, see sign on left - Honda Acres, take left onto Honda Road. Immediate right onto Schoolhouse Road. Farm 3/4 mile on left.

**From Westminster traveling on Route 97 North** - Past McDonalds in Littlestown. Right onto Whitehall Rd. 1 mile, turn right onto Littlestown Road. Go past Kosmos Farm, left onto Flatbush Road. Farm 1 mile on right.

**From Hanover traveling on Rt. 116 towards Gettysburg** - Take a left on Littlestown Road. Go approximately 2.5 miles (Past the Flatbush Golf Course) and take a right on Flatbush Road. Swan Lake is 1/2 mile on your right.
