Quality Assurance/ KLO2 Surveys

Has someone you don't know called and told you they need to come out and do a QA or KLO2 visit? Don't worry, it doesn't mean that there is something wrong with the person's services or that we're trying to take away any services.

KLO 2 - (Kansas Lifestyle Outcomes 2): is a survey used by SRS to determine whether people who receive services are living their preferred lifestyle or if there is a plan in place to help them reach their lifestyle goals. SRS does KLO 2 surveys by randomly selecting clients who receive any type of service including case management. The SRS Quality Enhancement Coordinator will call the family and set up a time to visit with the person being served and the support team. SRS will also review the person's file, to assure that the provider is meeting the State and Federal regulations.

QA (Quality Assurance): Each community provider that provides Targeted Case Management is responsible for an annual on-site visit for individuals who receives TCM from their agency and one additional service. The QAC team will review a sample of consumers randomly selected by the SCDDO QA team. The SCDDO QA team will assign who will be reviewed every quarter. The Review shall include provisions to determine whether or not:

- * Service are provided consistent with the Person Centered Support Plan.
- * Services are provided in a manner that offers opportunities of choice to the person being served
- * The Community Support Provider is affording the person being served all of the person's legally protected rights; Service that are paid for are delivered.
